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# THE ROLE OF INDIVIDUAL FACTORS IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OF YOUTH SOCIAL ACTIVITY

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### Abstract

Every change that occurs in the lives of young people affects the formation of their human qualities and their development as complete individuals. The role of interpersonal relationships in the formation of spiritual values, the inner spirit of a person (nation), their intelligence, their self-awareness, the fullness of good deeds and noble intentions is of great importance.

### Introduction

Of course, providing benefits for students studying in these educational institutions is also important. Our state is also paying attention to this aspect of the problem.

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One third of graduates are involved in vocational education, which will ensure employment for young people. Currently, due to the lack of qualified personnel in some professions in Uzbekistan, qualified specialists are being invited from foreign countries.

Qualified specialists from Turkey, South Korea, Germany, India, and Japan are proof of our opinion. So, we believe that attracting qualified trainers and specialists from these countries to Uzbekistan will not be without benefits. In our opinion, it is important to encourage them in the training of qualified specialists. This process will encourage those working in each educational institution to increase their responsibility. In particular, it is necessary to attract them to improve their qualifications in prestigious universities and foreign universities, therefore, when allocated from the state budget, the interest of employees in their profession will increase. In another aspect, the private sector also plays a big role in training young people to ensure their activities in the formation of civil society. In our opinion, assisting them in their development is also a requirement of the time. It is necessary to expand networks and facilitate the issuance of licenses. Reducing secondary requirements, providing them with long-term rental facilities, and exempting them from customs duties on foreign vocational training manuals and textbooks will also have a positive impact on the development of private vocational education.

The practical activities of the Ulugbek Foundation for the Support of Talented Youth, established to educate young people who are considered the future of the country and the future of our nation, to encourage talented youth, to further expand their intellectual capabilities, and to support their aspirations for science, culture, and spirituality, are also noteworthy. The state bears the costs of purchasing school uniforms and school supplies once a year for children from families included in the "Iron Notebook", "Women's Notebook" and "Youth

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Notebook.”<sup>2</sup>

The efforts of the "Umid" and "Ustoz" foundations operating in this direction in our republic are yielding positive results. The restoration of history, historical memory and the education of young people on this basis are of great importance. The beginning of a new creative mastery of the great spiritual heritage of our great ancestors, who made a significant contribution to world civilization, is certainly one of the most striking achievements of independent Uzbekistan. The scientific and literary heritage of Imam al-Bukhari, Imam at-Termizi, Khoja Ahmad Yassavi, Bahauddin Naqshband, al-Khwarizmi, Al-Farghani, Abu Raykhan Beruni, Mirzo Ulugbek, Alisher Navoi and other great thinkers is of great importance in the education of young people. Also, the fact that the anniversaries of the ancient cities of our country, such as Samarkand, Shakhrisabz, Bukhara, and Khiva, are celebrated on a global scale also serves to further enhance the love of the country among young people. Considering the specific importance of various factors in the implementation of youth activism, it is worth emphasizing that values play an important role in this.

Values are a very complex and multifaceted concept. Therefore, various definitions have been given to it in the literature. One of them, for example, is described in the Uzbek Soviet Encyclopedia, which says: “Value is a concept used to indicate the human, social and cultural significance of certain phenomena in reality.”<sup>3</sup>

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In general, the Uzbek people have wonderful human qualities, rare family traditions, and values that the world has recognized. For example, not eating until all family members are gathered, standing up to greet parents as the head of the family. Always showing them kindness, respecting elders, being kind to younger ones, never sparing help to neighbors, relatives, neighbors, acquaintances, and others are examples of this.

As our great thinker Alisher Navoi said, respecting parents is an obligation for children. It is necessary to treat both of them equally and serve them equally. Perform all services with decency, including your stature, like the "dol" in the word "decency".<sup>4</sup>

In the process of forming a civil society, it is our duty to pass on our native language, national values, ancient customs and traditions, the glorious deeds and heroism of our ancestors, and the ancient monuments built by their labor to future generations, so that they can be proud of their history and enhance national pride.

It should be noted that patriotism includes respecting and appreciating the past of other nations, along with the history of one's own people. It is the duty of the current generation to instill in the younger generation a sense of respect for the work of the past and a sense of appreciation for it.

The doctrine of Moturidiya, based on the idea of tolerance in the process of acquiring knowledge, pays great attention to the role and importance of human intelligence. This, in turn, played an important role in the widespread popularization of this doctrine. Humanity still feels a great need for such ideas today.<sup>5</sup>

Speaking about the computer-Internet, this area is becoming more advanced than other means. The President of the Republic of Uzbekistan specifically pointed out the following in this regard: “The tasks of in-depth study of special subjects, the history of our country and world civilization, foreign languages, and modern computer programs by children and young people have not yet been solved qualitatively and fully. Here, we are talking, first of all, about creating the necessary environment and conditions for the widespread promotion of the rich history of our country, its unique culture and national values among young people and the population, and for communicating the achievements of world science and literature. In this regard, it is necessary to take into account the fact that modern computer technologies, and especially the Internet system, are much ahead of us.”<sup>6</sup> So, we cannot allow a gap to form in our spirituality. In the face of this void, it is the need of the hour to fill it with a new lifestyle, new traditions, and values that are in line with the interests and actions of young

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people in science, professions, a positive lifestyle, and construction work. So, how can we protect the younger generation from being led astray and being influenced by undesirable trends during the period of civil society formation? The **first of them** is to base this struggle on the ancient traditions of our people, their customs, language, religion, spirituality, worldview and thinking that serve our national development today, and **the second is to rely on universal and modern values and achievements**. It is necessary to emphasize the need to harmonize these principles with each other, defining them as the most important goals set before us .

Therefore, it is our duty to educate the young people who are coming of age in all respects based on the requirements of the ideology of national independence, to educate them to be intellectually, physically, morally mature, knowledgeable, proud, confident, strong-willed, independent, free-thinking, with a broad worldview, politically and legally sound, consistent in word and deed, and loyal to national and universal values. No one has the right to stand aside in this. This means not feeling responsible, indifference, and ignorance, and ultimately, such an approach creates an ideological vacuum. If the vacuum is not filled by progressive ideas, other alien, selfish views will fill it. It will lead to its own destruction, and then the wasted time, money, and energy will be very expensive. Unexpected unpleasant events may occur. Thinkers have also taught that such vices should absolutely not exist in a civil society.

As the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan Sh. Mirziyoyev noted, “Today's rapidly changing world opens up new and great opportunities for humanity, for young people. At the same time, it exposes them to various evil dangers that have never been seen before. Malicious forces are turning naive, cave children against their parents, their country, and are taking their lives and livelihoods.

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"In such a tense and dangerous situation, we, parents, teachers, the public, and the community, must increase our vigilance and awareness on this issue. We must raise our children ourselves, not leave them in the hands of others <sup>7</sup>. "

The effectiveness of ideological education depends, first of all, on a clear definition of what the result of ideological education of society should be. Then the path will be opened to the extent to which the ideology of the youth of the new Uzbekistan will improve the above-mentioned specific qualities.

Speaking about the special importance of spiritual and educational factors in the implementation of youth activism, it is necessary to note the role of the mahalla. The mahalla has long been a place of wisdom, a place of patriotism, full of oriental lifestyle, national customs, traditions, folk customs. Social life in mahallas is considered one of the factors that determine the content of the life of the country. Such processes are also similar to civil society. From ancient times in the East, the philosophical wisdom that "a wedding with a council will not be dissolved" is based on this.

The neighborhood has a unique opportunity to educate young people with faith, compassion, dedication to service to their families and the country, and loyalty to their homeland.

### Conclusion

Every young person, with the support of their mothers and the approval of their community, rises to the level of patriotism, selflessness, and wisdom. Because both good and evil are known in the community. Unfortunately, Uzbekistan ranks 104th out of 142 countries in the crime rate ranking.
